Judging Observations

Storyteller:

General

- Storyteller is visible
- Storyteller is audible
- Storyteller delivered the whole story in one 'go'

Content:

- Setting the scene
- Story development
- Appropriate close
- Creative transitions via link line

Delivery:

- Commanding presence
- Eye contact
- Use of voice
- Use of gestures
- Moving speaking space
- Holding a strong finishing position

Introducer:

General

- Storyteller is visible
- Storyteller is audible
- Storyteller delivered the whole story in one 'go'
- The name of the storyteller very clear and audible.

Clarity and delivery

- The name of the story very clear and audible.
- The blah blah blah name rule is clearly used.
- Confident delivery

Whole class participation

On completion of the programme, you can request a Mighty Oak Storytelling certificate of participation for distribution to your whole class

Purple star award

On completion of the programme, you can request a Mighty Oak Purple Star certificate for distribution at your discretion.

Teacher's award

On completion of the programme, you can request a Mighty Oak Teacher's award certificate for any pupil for any reason. If you send us the details of the winner and the reason why the certificate is being awarded, we will fill in the certificate. We will then send the completed certificate to you with a copy and note to the school principle or head teacher.

Guidelines for the Showcase

- All entries should have an introducer and a storyteller.
- The storyteller can tell any story of their choosing
 - From the programme
 - Of their own
 - From the curriculum
- The storyteller can choose any title for their story.
- The storyteller should deliver the whole story in one video recording.
- The storyteller should be in the camera frame when they are speaking.
- The story should not exceed two minutes.
- The introducer should be in the camera frame, the whole time they are speaking.
- All recordings should be audible.

Submitting your entry

There are three steps to submitting your storytelling entry:

Step 1

Fill in the registration form which you will have received from our office when you started the programme. You can enter as many of your class as you wish. Each entry costs nothing. Please fill in the accompanying consent form. Please fill in the students names and the school name as you would like it to appear on our certificates.

Step 2

Ensure that you have a good clear video recording of both the introducer and the storyteller, where both students are fully visible and audible when speaking. The storyteller must tell the whole story straight through.

Step 3

Upload the video to our secure server. You will be given the link and instructions as soon as we receive the registration form. ****Note the video recordings will only be viewed by the judges, after which, any videos without full permissions to remain, will be deleted from the server. (See GDPR)**

Please state the name of the storyteller, the name of the school AND the location of the school, clearly in the information box when submitting the video entry.

Step 4

You will be notified of the results after the Showcase.

All pupils who participate in the programme will receive a certificate of participation. Further awards are given according to judges observations. (Please see awards)
